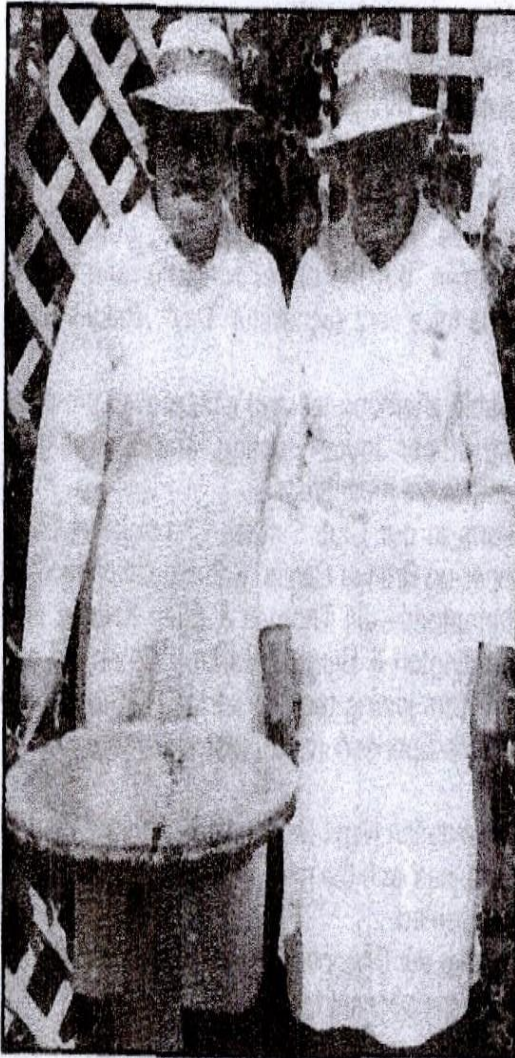
Judith Lang, a Club member, passed away recently. Her family have shared some of her memorabilia with us.
